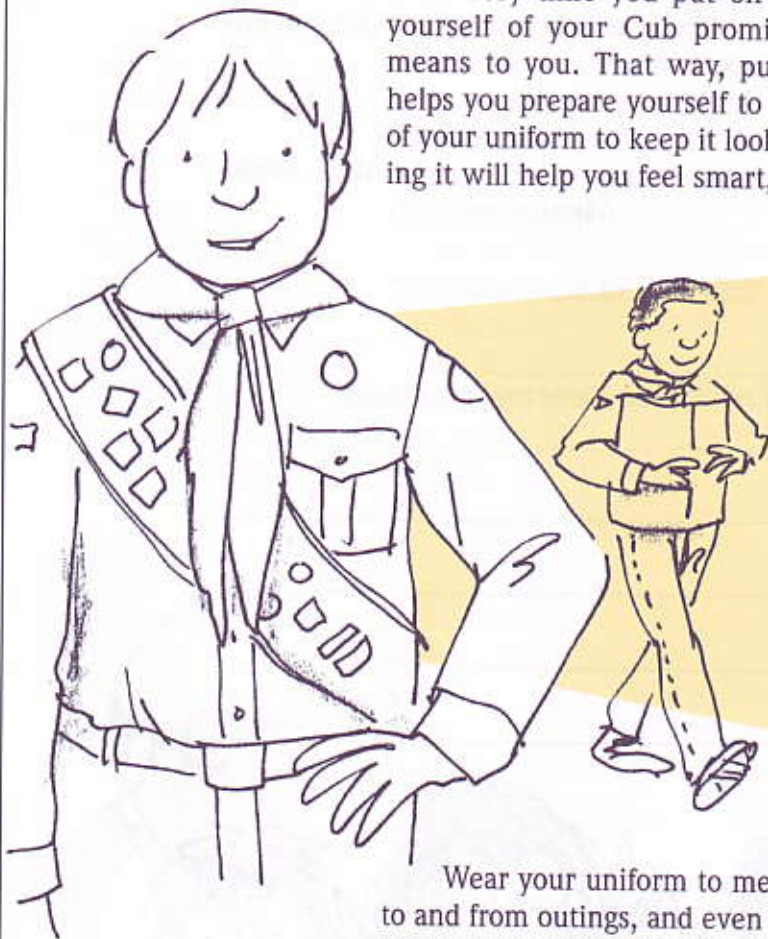


## The Wolf Cub Uniform
