| Cub | A child aged 8 to 10 who has joined the Wolf Cub program |
| Pack | All the Cubs, leaders and Kim together |
| Six | A group of Cubs within the pack |
| Sixer | A leader of a six |
| Second | The sixer's helper |
| Tenderpad | Refers to a new Cub before he or she is invested |
| Old Wolf | A term referring to any leader |
| Grand Howl | A welcome to Akela by the Cubs |
| Swimming-Up | A ceremony where a new Tenderpad comes into the pack from a Beaver colony |
| Going-Up (Advancement) | A ceremony when a Cub leaves the pack and goes on to the troop |

While you will be called Kim, most other leaders in the Pack will adopt jungle names. Here are some of the more common names and their meanings.
